Life Skill Activity

Gratitude

Fingerprint Card

Material Required:

You will need twine/rope, **brown paint**, a brown/black marker, and **glue**.

Steps:

- Dip thumbs into the brown paint and stamp it on the white piece of paper. After that, dip the pointer finger in the paint and press it right above the thumbprint, so that it shapes like a monkey.
- Cut a piece of rope/twine and glue it onto the paper just above the monkey bodies. Grab the brown marker and draw the tail, ears, arms, and legs!
- Finish the monkeys off by drawing black eyes and a dark brown circle/smile on their face. Write "I love hangin' with you Dad!" at the top of the card :)
- Open the card and write **a beautiful message for your father**
- **Click a picture** with your father while gifting him the card.
