

Describing Word Activity

" first graders developed vocabulary by using adjectives to describe their flower drawing. They learnt to identify and express characteristics such as color and size, enhancing their language skills. This creative exercise promotes critical thinking and observation. Overall, students gain confidence in using descriptive words to communicate their ideas effectively. Clothes -sorting activity -Clothes Sorting Activity,

" first graders sorted clothing items based on the four seasons. They learned to identify which clothes were suitable for winter, spring, summer, and fall. This activity enhanced their understanding of seasona changes and the associated weather. Students developed critical thinking skills as they categorized item and discussed their choices. Overall, they gained confidence in making connections between clothing and the seasons.

Paper Dandiya Sticks using old newspaper -

"Paper Dandiya Sticks Making" activity, first graders created sticks using old newspapers, promoting sustainability and recycling. They learned the importance of reusing materials and reducing waste in a creative way. This hands-on project fostered environmental awareness and encouraged innovative thinking.


