

Alumni Speak@Careers Event at Banyan Tree School



On 13th November 2024, Banyan Tree School held the Alumni Speak @ Careers event as part of its Parent Connect Series. The event provided students with a unique opportunity to gain insights into various career paths through the experiences of the school's accomplished alumni. The event began with a warm welcome and an overview of the purpose of the session. The aim was to inspire and guide students by showcasing the diverse career opportunities that lie ahead of them. The first guest speaker was Mr. Pranay Nath Jha, an alumnus from the Class of 2002. Mr. Jha, a seasoned lawyer with over 16 years of experience practicing at the High Court and District Court in Delhi, shared his fascinating journey in the legal profession.

Mr. Jha began by reflecting on his school life at Banyan Tree School, recalling how the foundation laid during his school years helped him navigate the challenges in his career. He went on to explain how his academic interests evolved from history to law, ultimately leading him to pursue a career in the legal field. He emphasized that law is an adaptable profession and discussed the different pathways one can take to become a lawyer, whether through a 5-year law degree or the traditional 3+3 structure, where three years of undergraduate study is followed by three years of law school. Mr. Jha also detailed his career journey, beginning with his early roles in legal advisory positions and expanding to his work with tier-1 law firms, such as RNC Legal, where he briefed senior advocates in prominent cases. He discussed his experience working under the mentorship of Hon'ble Justice Sanjeev Narula of the Delhi High Court and highlighted the variety of roles and career options within the legal profession. Mr. Jha's insights into the rewards and challenges of the legal profession provided a thought-provoking perspective for students considering law as a career.

Following Mr. Jha, the next speaker, Ms. Shipra Goyal, took the stage. A graduate from the Class of 2017, Ms. Goyal is currently a Capabilities & Insights Analyst at McKinsey & Company, specializing in human resource consulting and organizational culture. Ms. Goyal shared how her experiences at Banyan Tree School had shaped her and prepared her for the opportunities she later encountered. She explained how her journey after school led her to pursue a Bachelor's in Applied Psychology from Amity University, followed by a Master's degree from Christ University, Bangalore. After completing her studies, she transitioned into the field of management consulting



In her speech, Ms. Goyal explained what management consulting entails, offering students an in-depth understanding of the consulting industry and the skills required for success. She emphasized the importance of problem-solving, research, and the ability to work with diverse teams in the ever-evolving business world. Drawing from her background in organizational psychology, Ms. Goyal spoke about how she applies her knowledge of human behavior and workplace dynamics in her consulting work, helping organizations optimize their cultures and improve performance. Her insights into the intersection of psychology and business offered a unique perspective on the role of management consultants.

After both speeches, the floor was opened for a Q&A session, allowing students to engage directly with the speakers. Mr. Jha and Ms. Goyal answered each question thoughtfully, providing further guidance on how students can shape their futures. As the event concluded, the a V ote of Thanks was delivered, expressing gratitude to Mr. Pranay Nath Jha and Ms. Shipra Goyal for their time and for sharing their valuable experiences.




ACHIEVEMENTS


