

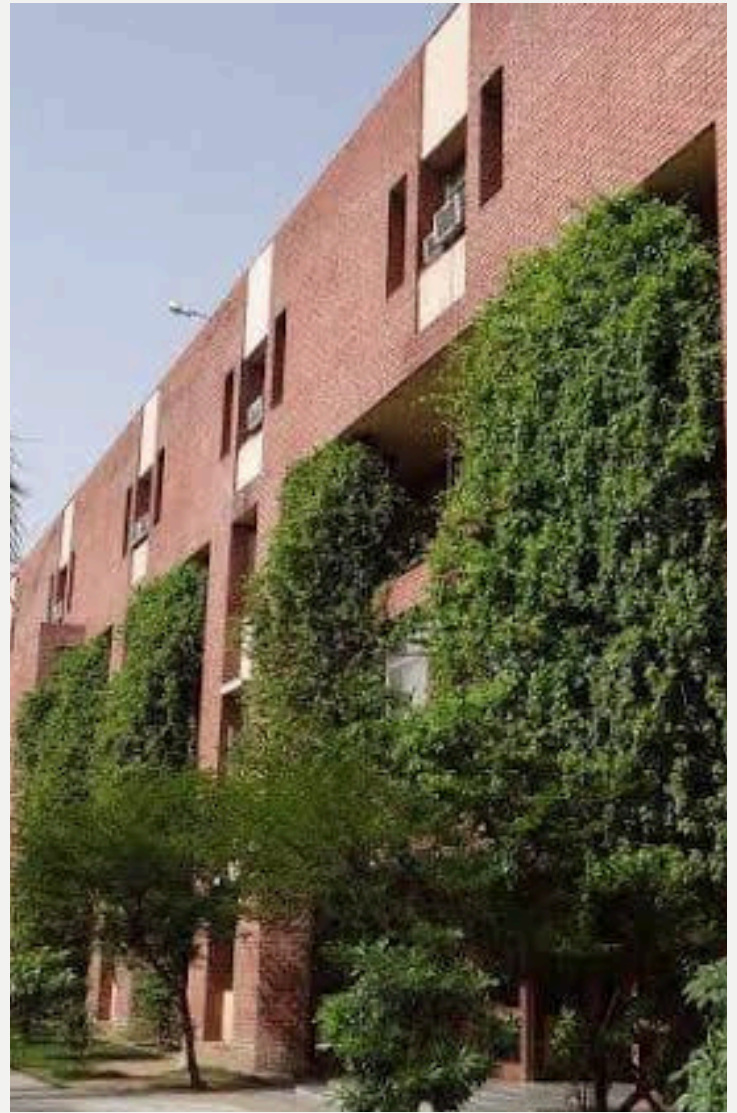

Winter Wonderland in the Making!

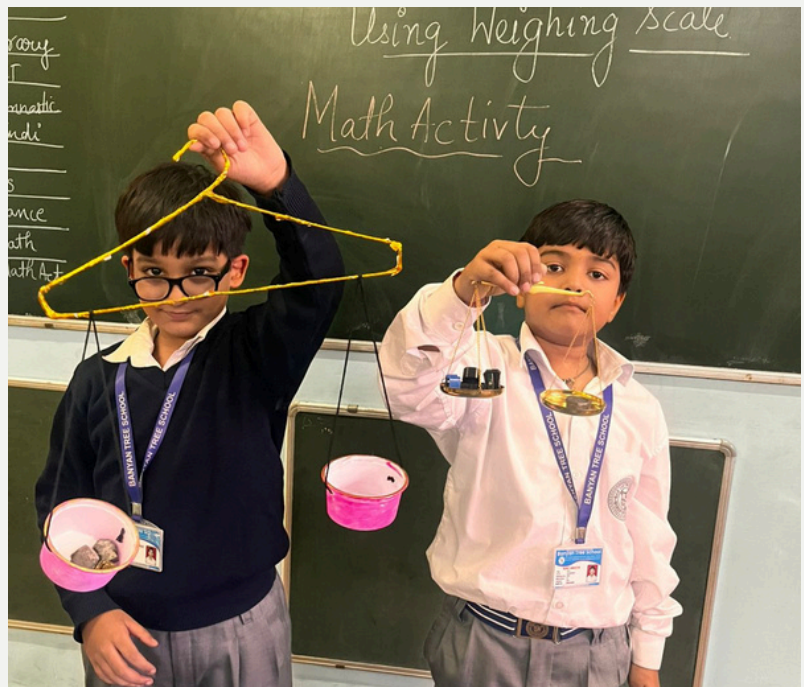

We're loving the way our young artists are exploring their creativity and fine motor skills through this engaging activity.



Money Matters Activity - In this activity, Grade 1 students explored different coins and notes to learn their values. They used play money to practice exchanging coins and notes for equal amounts. Working in pairs, they bought and sold pretend items, making sure to use the correct coins and notes. Through these hands-on experiences, students gained a better understanding of how money works in real life. By the end of the activity, they identified various types of coins and notes, understood their value, and practiced exchanging money accurately. They also learned how to make simple transactions, which helped them gain an early understanding of money and its uses.



Students did a role play on Bhalu ka ghar using props of the characters . It was very well portrayed and was a motivational activity for the students . The students enjoyed playing the play simultaneously and they learnt about the basic traits of the animals .



In the metric measures class, students participated in an engaging activity using 'Jodo Gyan' weighing kits to explore various units of weight. 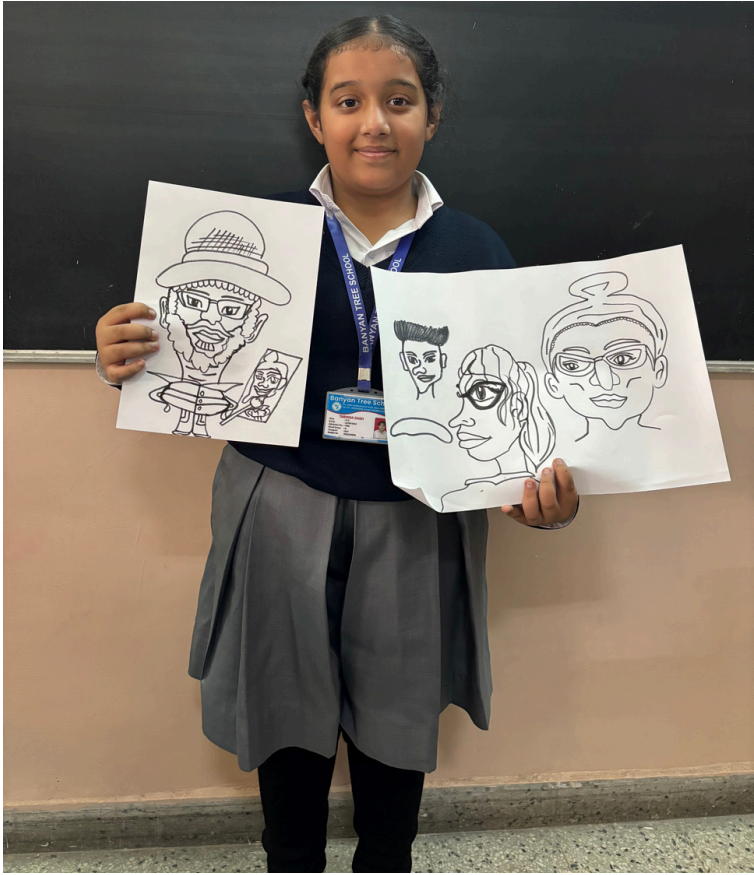

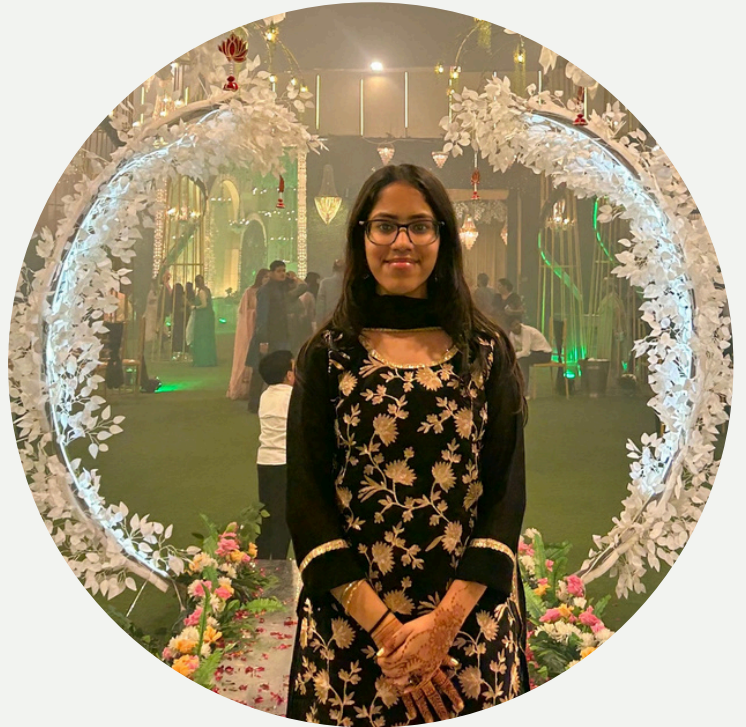
