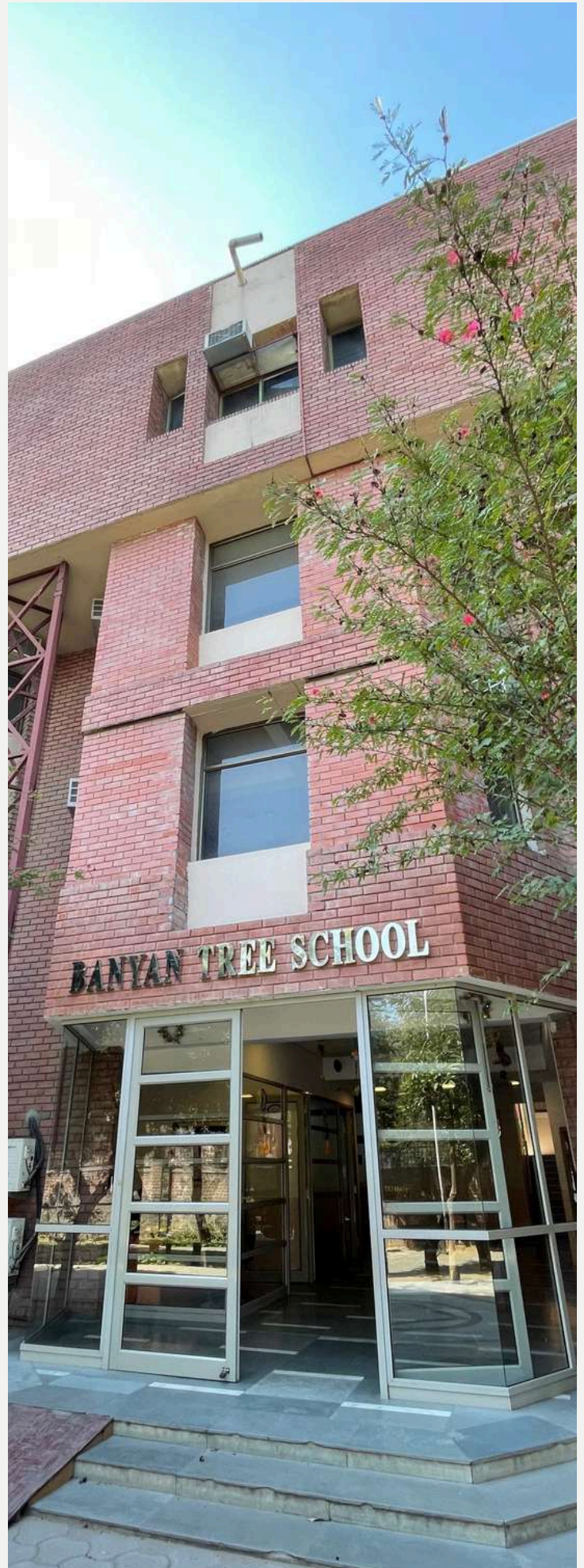

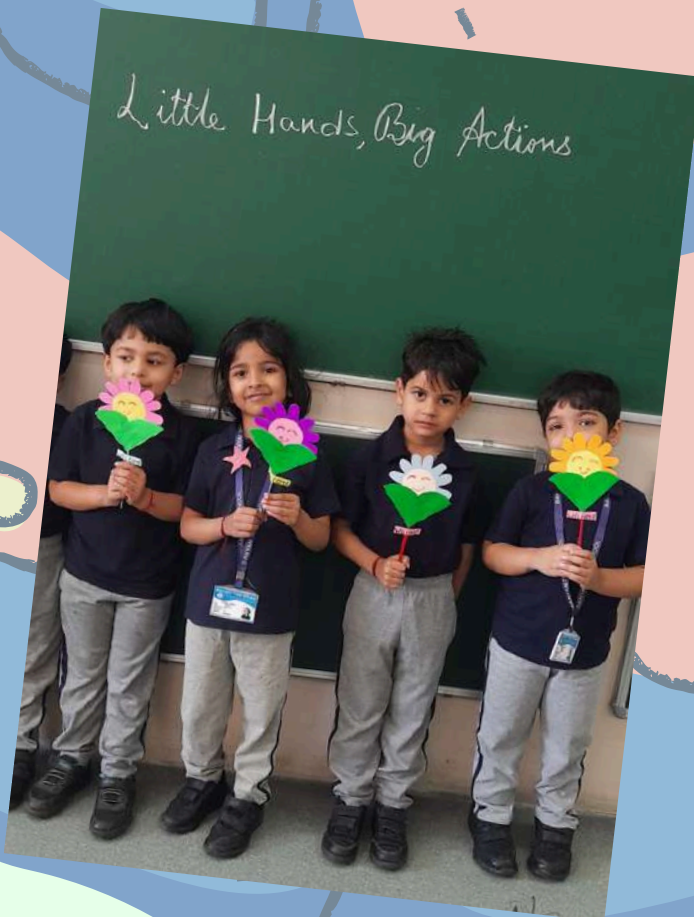

Each Day Earth Day

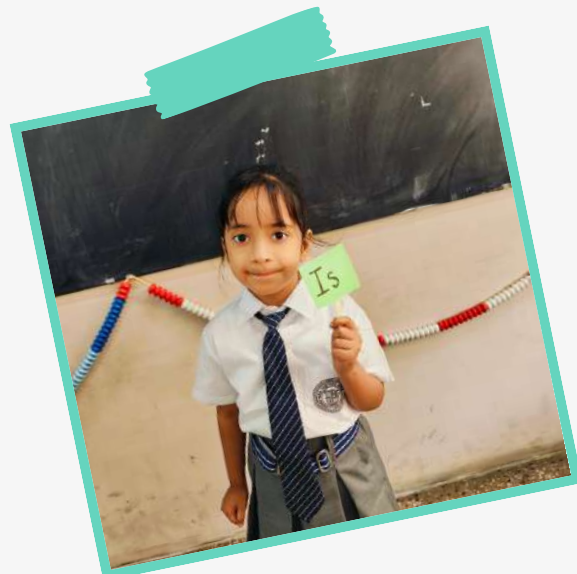

Discover Red... One Activity at a time

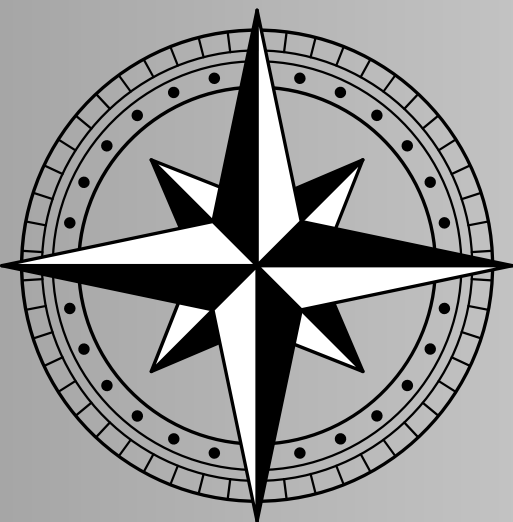

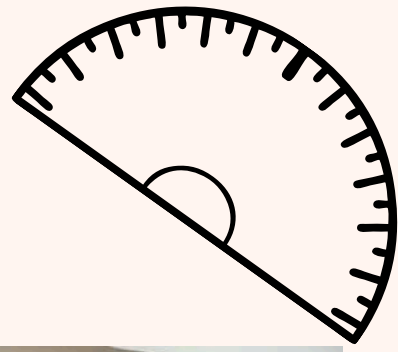




Explore, Discover...Without GPS

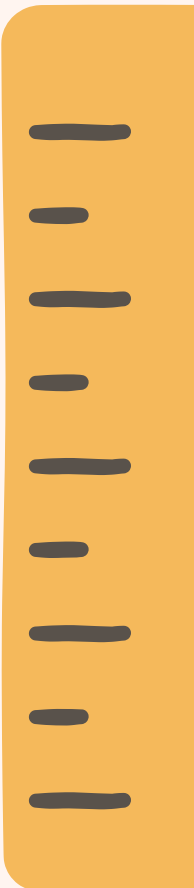

The students pledged to spread the message of dengue prevention in their homes and communities.

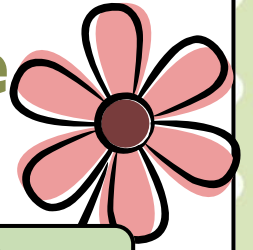
The activity not only enhanced their knowledge but also empowered them to become young ambassadors of public health and hygiene.

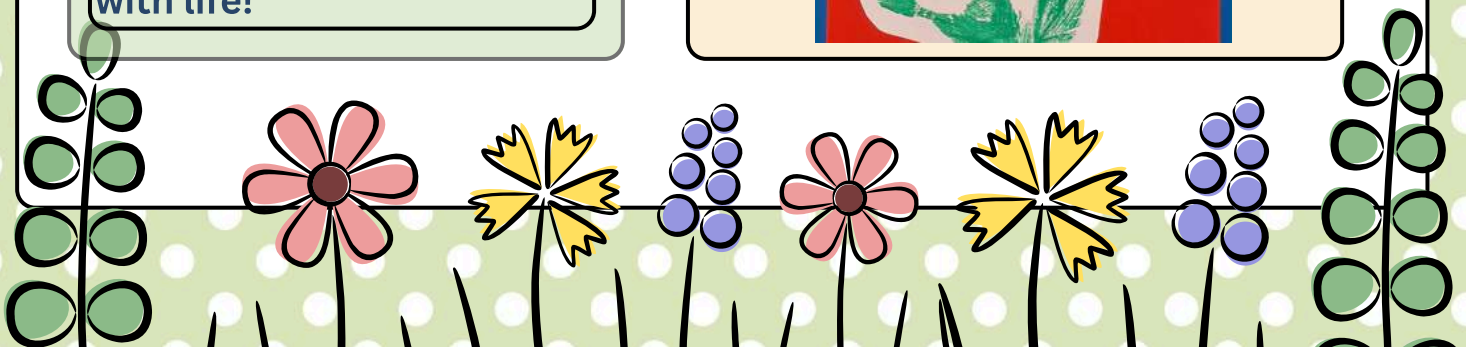


Roots of Our Family
