

CHILDREN'S DAY




Children's Day was celebrated with storytelling, fun games, and creative craft activities, making the session joyful, engaging, and memorable.






NATIONAL POSTER COMPETITION 'TREE OF LIFE'

FRACTION QUEST SNAKES, LADDERS AND LEARNING




Grade VI students enjoyed Fraction Quest, a game-based activity that made learning fractions fun, interactive, and engaging.





Mother Dairy Plant


