# Learning Beyond the Classroom

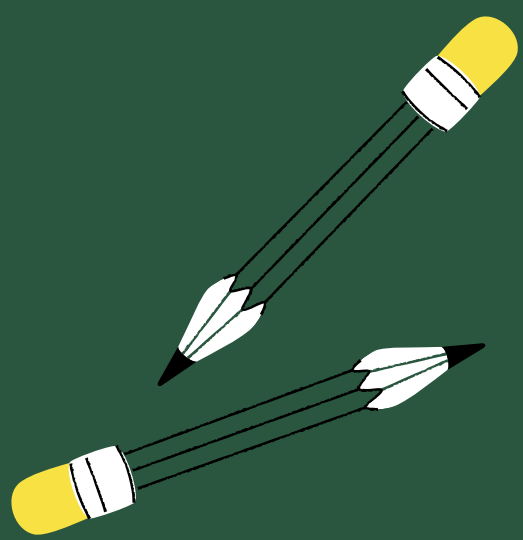

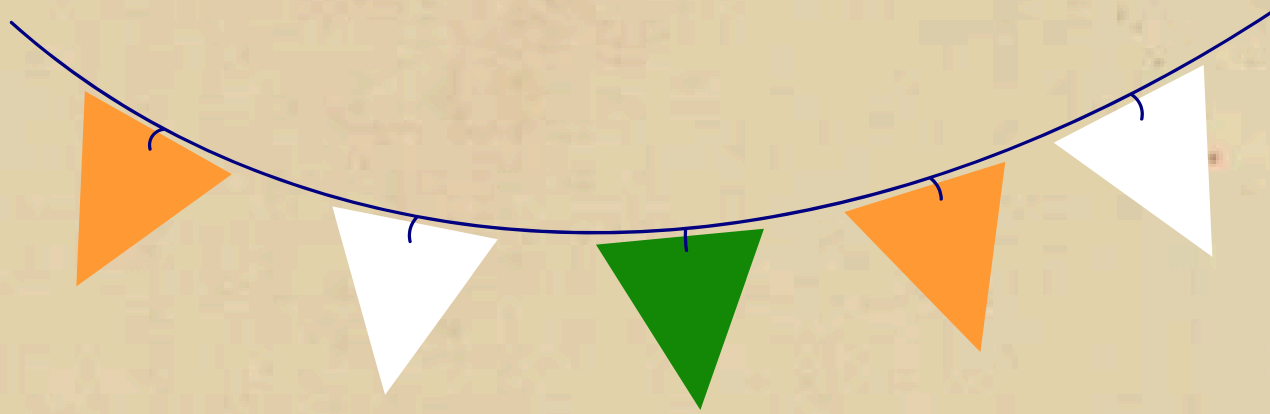
## ORIENTATION PROGRAMME (KG-V)

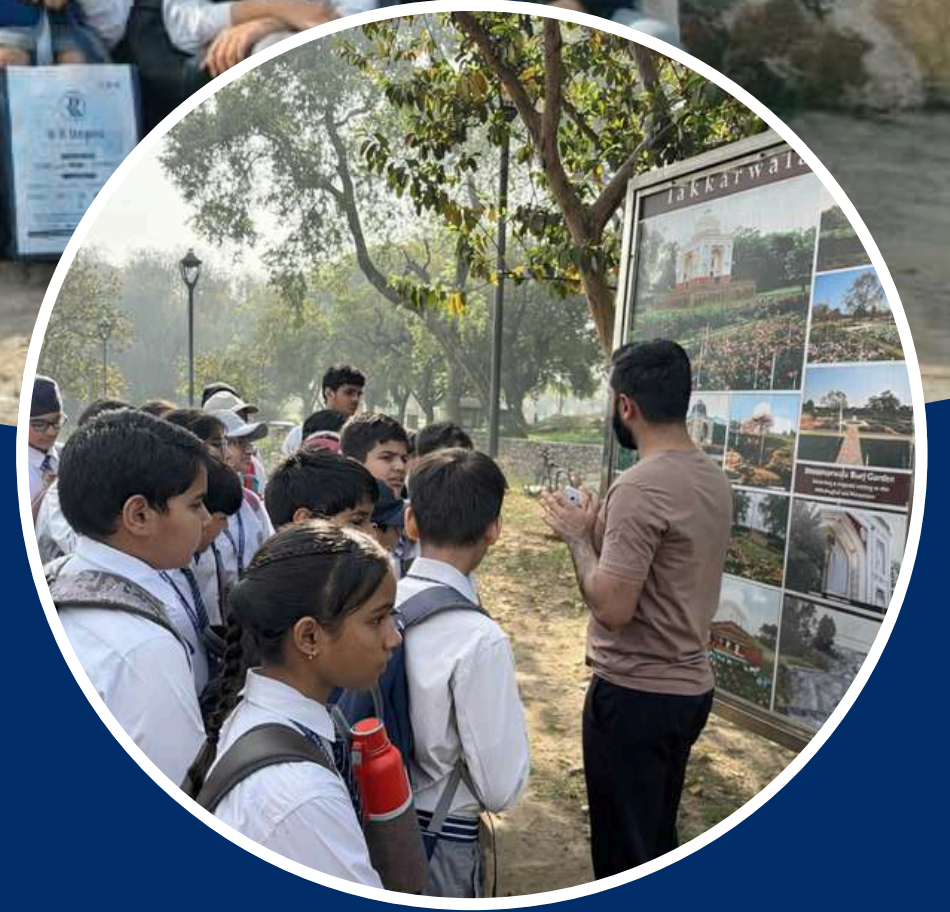
