II. Create Your Own Word World

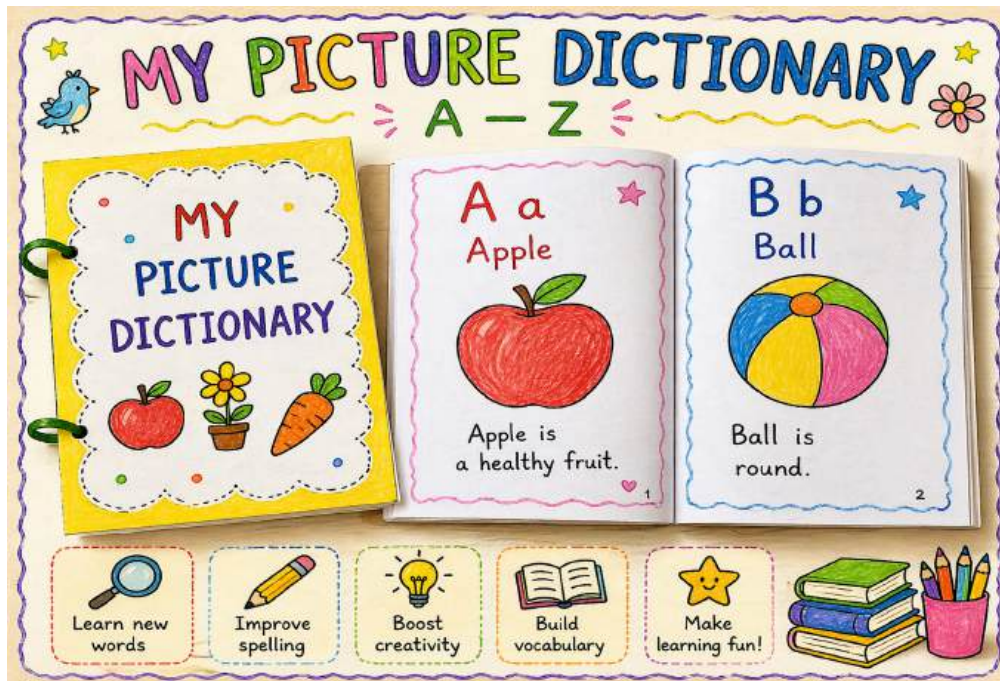
Collect words, draw pictures, and become a word wizard!

I. My Time Wheel

Tick-tock goes the clock, let's learn time around the clock

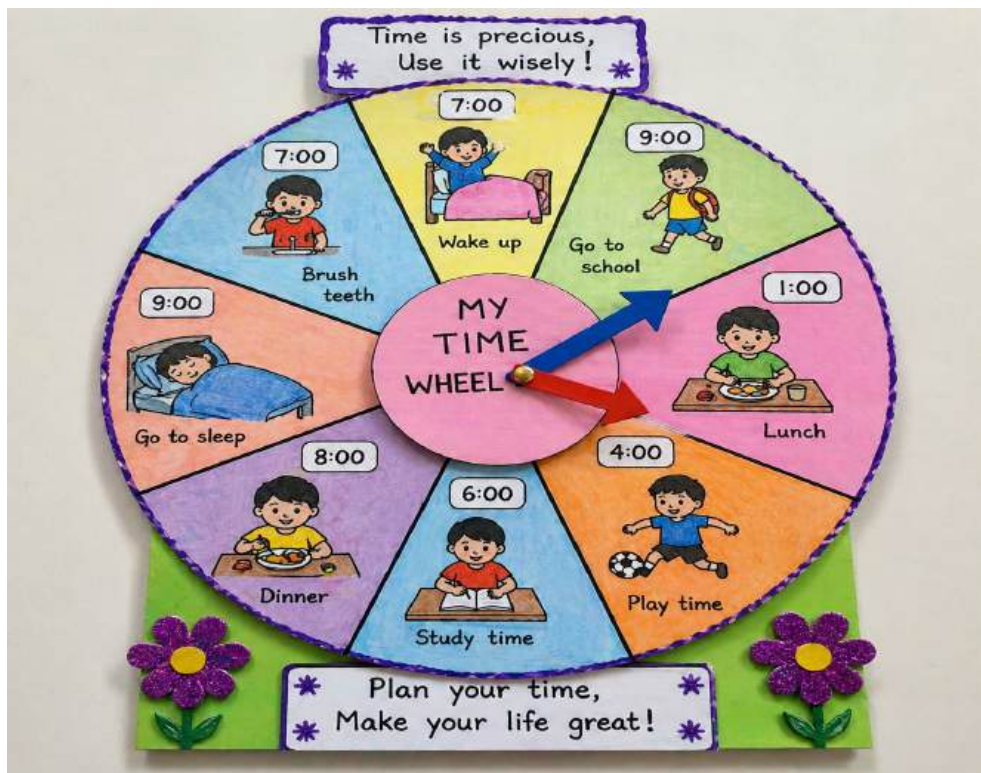
Time is a part of our everyday life—from waking up to going to bed!

In this project, you will create your own **Time Wheel Model** to understand daily routines and reading time in a fun and interactive way.

Make a **Time Wheel** that shows different times of the day along with your daily activities.

Steps to Follow:

- Take a circular base (like a paper plate or cardboard circle).
- Divide it into **6–8 equal parts**.
- Write different times in each section (e.g., 7:00, 9:00, 1:00, 4:00).
- Draw or paste pictures of activities for each time (wake up, school, play, eat, sleep).
- Make clock hands using paper and fix them in the centre.
- Move the hands to match the time shown in each section.
- Label your wheel neatly.

Environmental Studies

I. In the Company of Green Spaces

Let's create a greener world with our tiny hands

Let's get ready to create something beautiful and sustainable with our own magical hands. Casting the spell through our hands, building little green homes and leaving a bigger impact.

So, let's get ready to cast some green magic.

What to Do:

- Cut 4 pieces of cardboard to make walls. Make 2 of them with a triangle (house shape) on top. Cut a big square hole in the middle of each piece for windows.
- Take clear plastic wrap or sheets and cut them slightly bigger than the holes. Stick them over the holes with glue or tape so you can see through them.
- Join all 4 walls together using tape or glue to form a box. Then fix this box onto a flat cardboard base.
- Cut 2 rectangular pieces for the roof and attach them on top to make a peak. Tape only one side so you can open it like a lid.
- Place small plant pots inside and keep the greenhouse in a sunny spot.



II. The hand printed Zoo

Making a mark for our animal friends

Simple shapes transform into lively animals, reminding us of the many creatures that share our surroundings. Create handprints of any four different animals using ivory or A4 size sheets as base.

Procedure:

- Coat your palm and fingers with a thin layer of washable paint.
- Press your hand firmly onto an A4 or ivory sheet. Keep your fingers pointing down so they look like legs.
- Let the handprint dry completely so the paint doesn't smudge.
- Use sketch pens to add details like eyes, ears, tails, or spots to turn each handprint into animals like an elephant, lion, or turtle.
