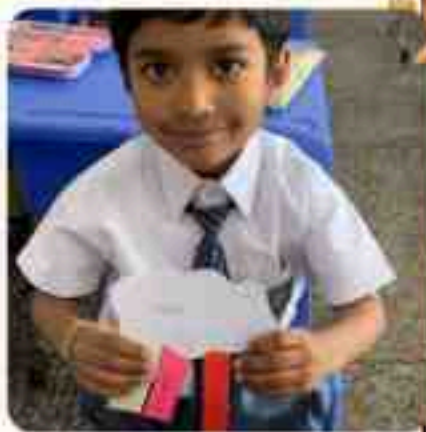


Explore & Discover

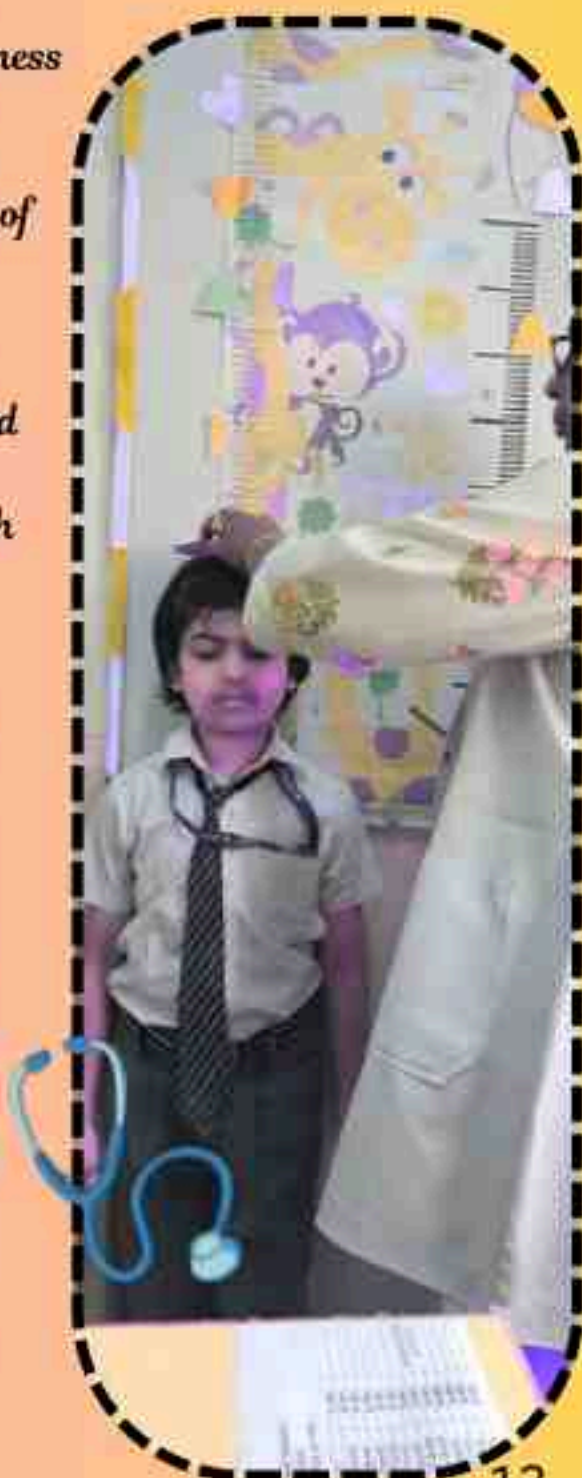
HEALTH & WELLNESS (LIFE SKILLS ACTIVITY)

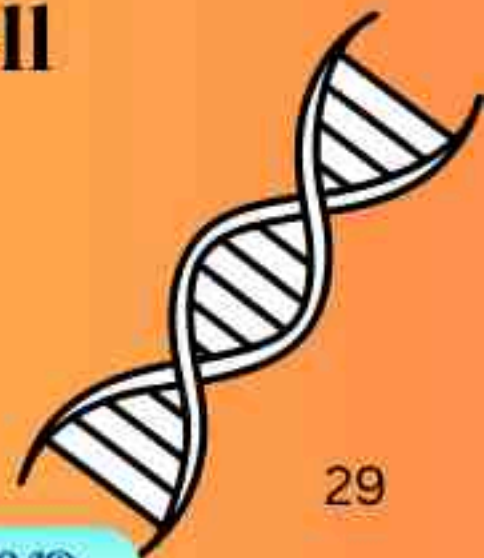


NATIONAL DNA DAY!

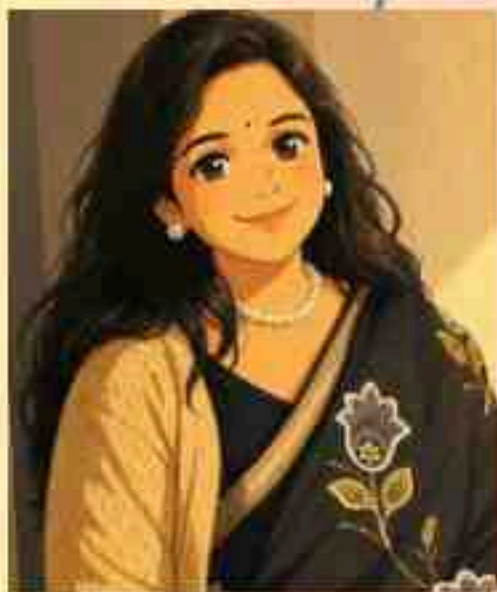

As we look ahead, we remain committed to nurturing not just scholars, but compassionate leaders of tomorrow.

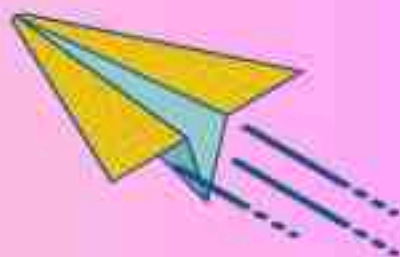
