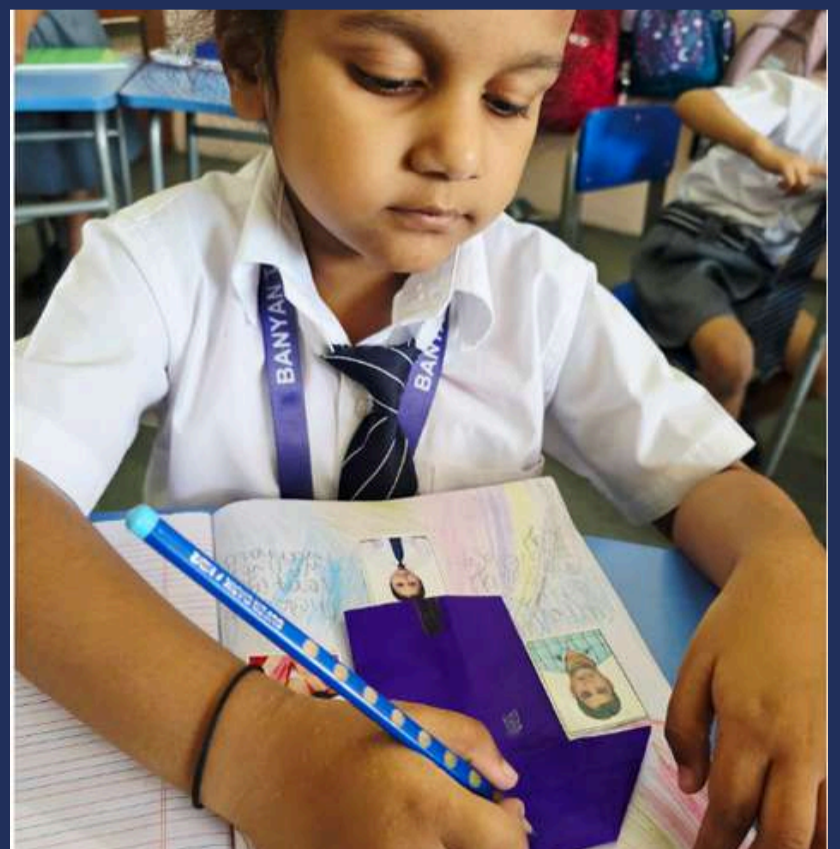

# WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY



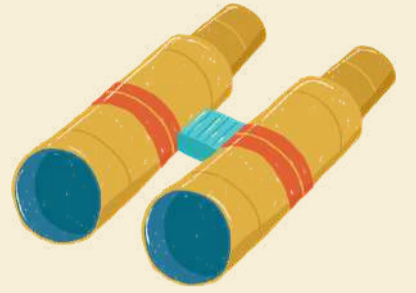

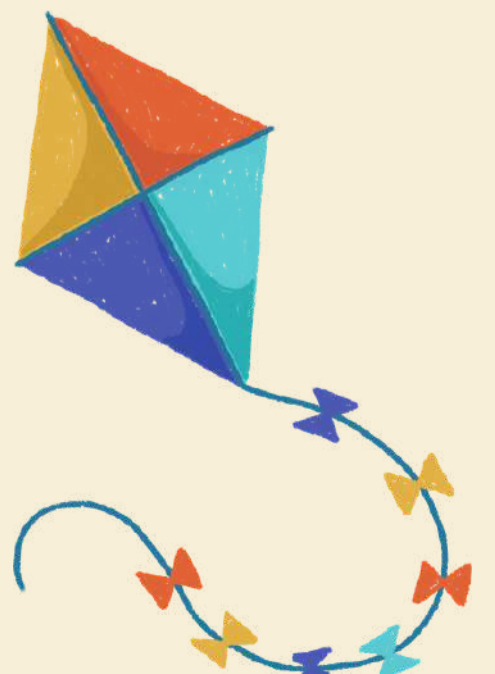


# KIDS SUMMERCAMP

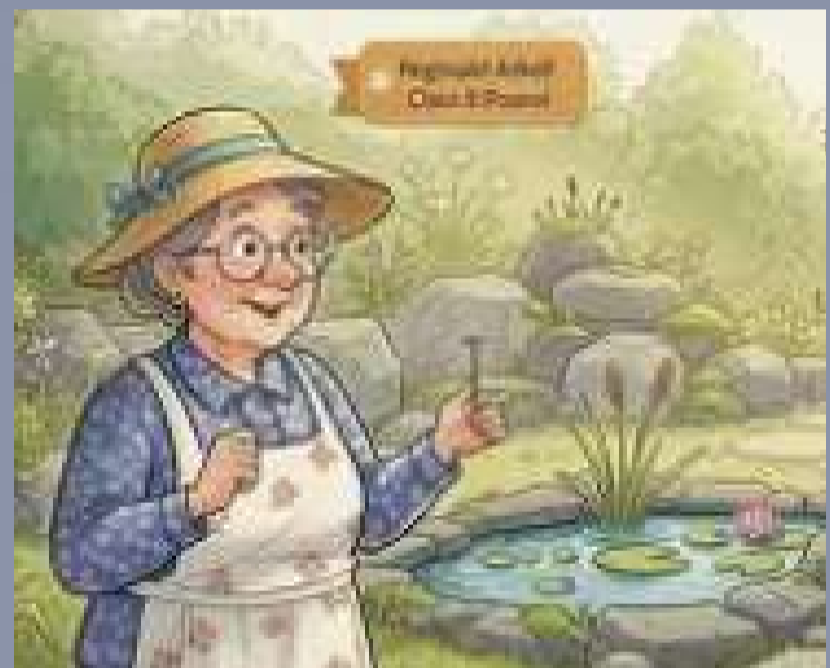

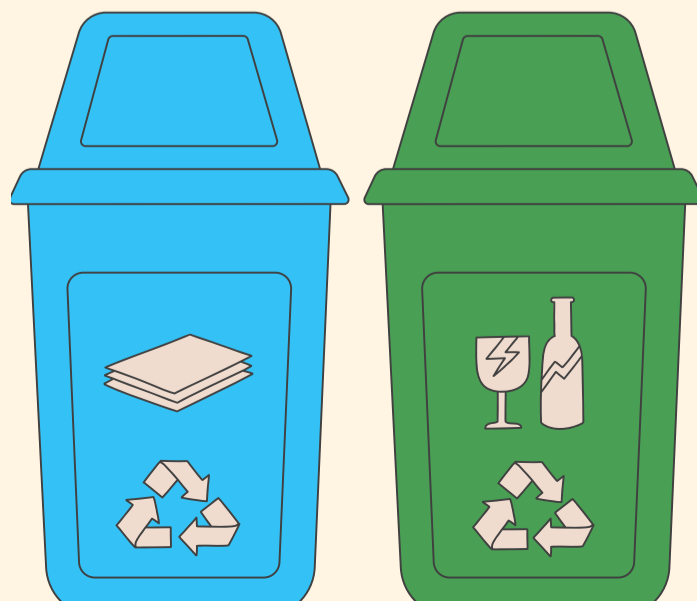




# Segregation of Waste

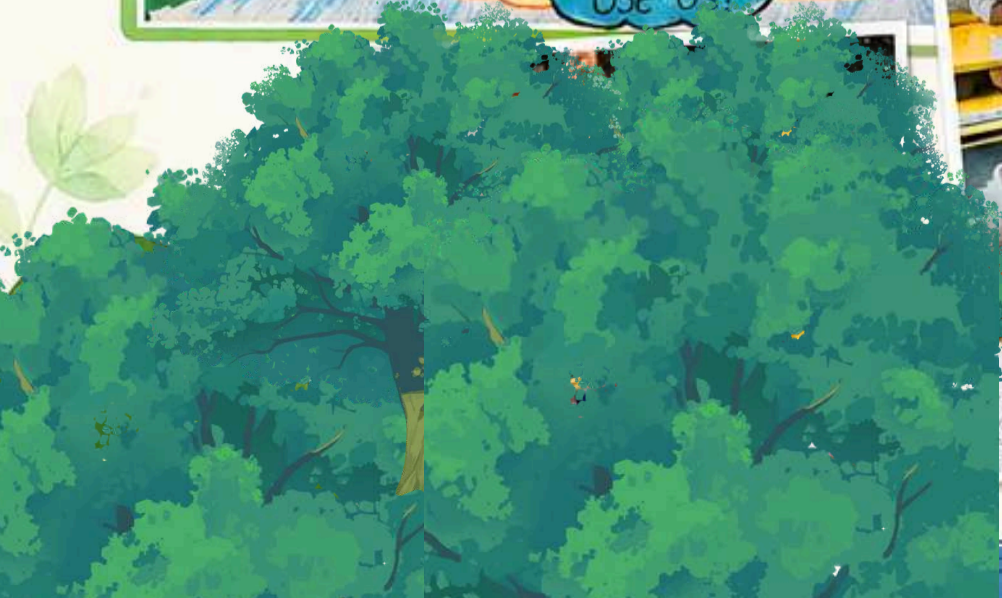

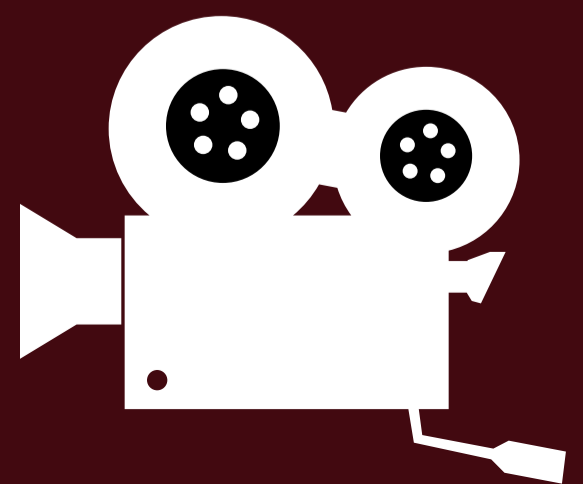

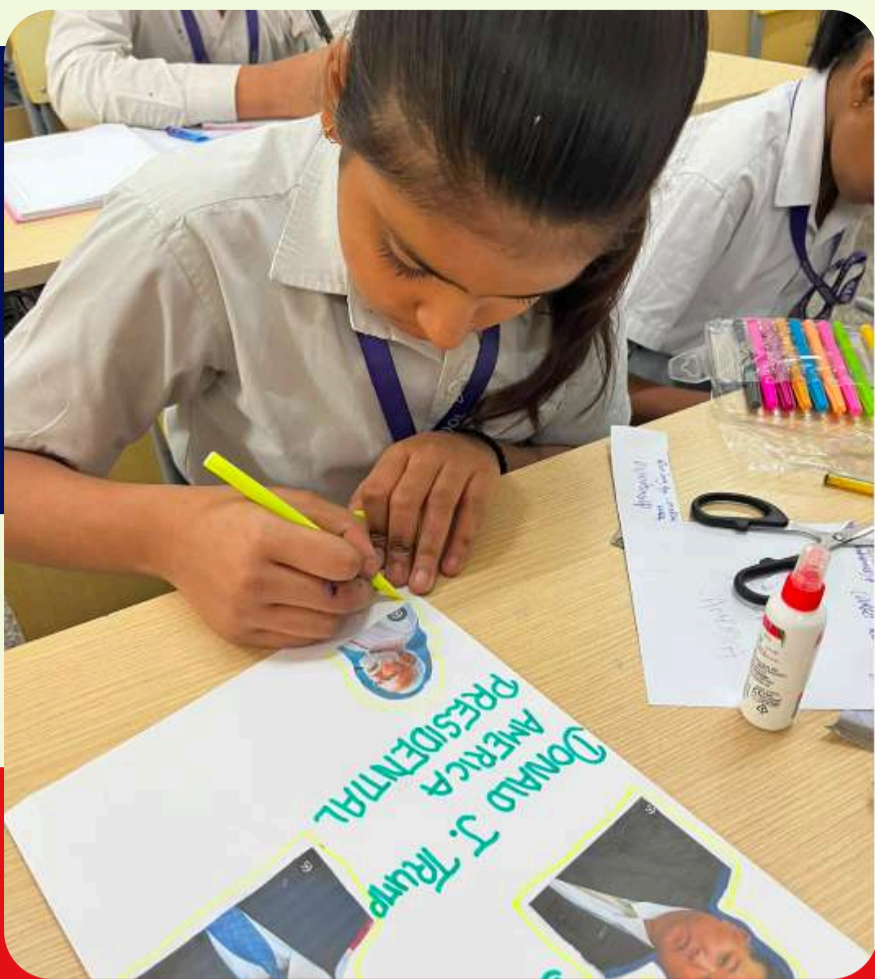
# LOST QUEEN - SULTANA BEGUM

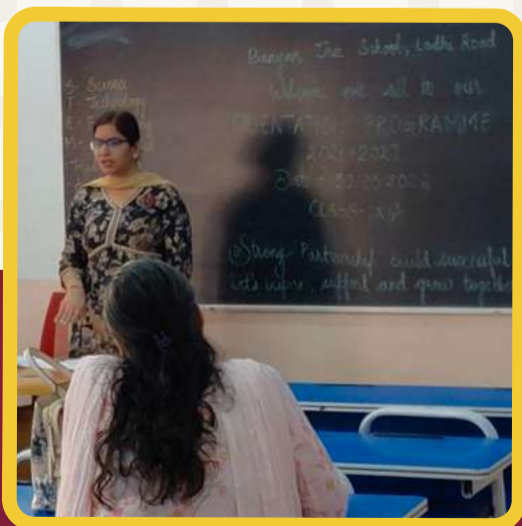




# PARENT TEACHER MEETING
