



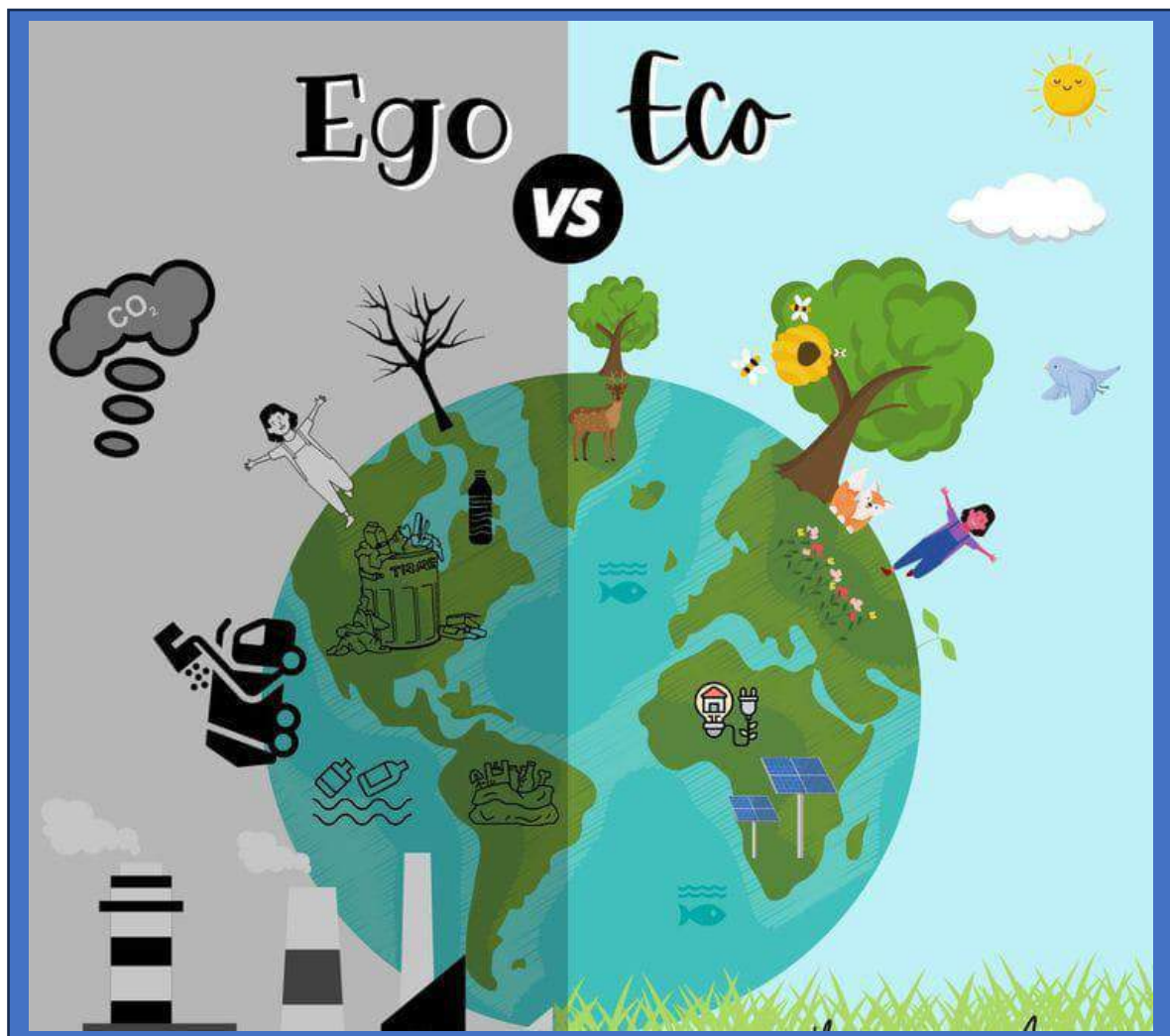

**Students of grade VI are assigned with a sensitive topic to introspect and decide,
The Role of Humans in survival of all the living species in the Ecosystems,
Who Are We?**

Each student needs to research through relevant sources like Science and Ecology books, Government Environmental Websites, Encyclopedias, think, discuss, make notes, design your perspective, project your learnings, and present your outcomes in the form of a Holiday Assignment.

To guide you in the background, here we have some points to refer to:

You may explore and find about the different kinds of **Ecosystems** around you.

You may explain the **components** of each Ecosystem.

You may identify various **living species** within each Ecosystem.

You may demonstrate a **sustainable living** project and show how individuals can reduce their **Ecological Footprint**.

You may include aspects like **waste reduction/ energy conservation/responsible consumption/climate change/habitat destruction**.

You may create an **Ecosystem Mapping**, highlighting the interconnectedness of various species.

You may choose a specific ecosystem or region and identify **human activities** that either support or threaten the balance within the ecosystem.

Showing your **mathematical abilities**, you may create tally charts to represent frequency of positive and negative impacts of human activities affecting the Ecosystems such as **Deforestation / Pollution / Recycling / Conservation** etc.

Using the knowledge gained by you in your opted **third language**, students preferring **Sanskrit** may also add on few shlokas mentioned in our **ancient scriptures** talking about Role of Humans in the Survival of Ecosystems or importance of humanity.

French learners may write a phrase or poem in French to express how humans have been living in harmony with nature since time immemorial.

You may also Explore the impact of human activities on the biodiversity and the survival of species by reading the brilliant book “**The Sixth Extinction**” by Elizabeth Kolbert.

Above are just a few ideas to portray, it is all your creativity and vision to give your study a dive in depth.

This is how, you will be enlightened about the Role of Humans in the survivals of all living species and possess the ability to comprehend “**WHO ARE WE**“!

Now, how to create one single beautiful project on the given topic “WHO ARE WE”?

All your research work could be presented in “**any one**” of the following modes mentioned below:

Power point presentation (10-15 slides)

OR

3D model. (Any size and dimensions.)

OR

Charts/ posters (size A1)

OR

Twisting the story of any war turning into peace

OR

Caricatures (size A3)

OR

Doodle art (size A3)

OR

Self-composed Poem (English/Hindi/ French/ Sanskrit)

OR

Flip book (10-15 pages)

OR

Slogan or Banner (Any size)

OR

Research paper (1000-1500 words)

Please note:

All the projects would be exhibited in the school premises.

Students not only need to display but will also be explaining the project in English during presentation. (poem will be presented in the chosen language).

Projects would be judged based on following criteria:

Depth of the research, content, clarity of speech, creativity, innovation & originality of thoughts.

Best ones would be rewarded during the school assembly by honourable Principal Ma'am and will be covered on the social media and various school platforms.

Date of uploading the pictures or softcopies of the final projects: 12th January. (link will be shared by the class teacher)

Date of submission in school: 18th to 20th January.
