Dear Parent,

It's vacation time again, a time to relax as well as to fruitfully occupy the children and keep their energies well directed. Enjoy the winter vacation with your child with fun filled indoor and outdoor activities. Talk about the wonders of nature with your child. Share your childhood memories. Children love to hear these stories. Creative activities like playing with clay, beads, paints and crayons are all time great favourites with the children.

We have planned some activities to keep the children positively engaged. "Reading is fun, loads of fun", Introduce your child to picture book, story books and converse with them to develop their vocabulary and communication skills by encouraging them to talk about the pictures they see in the storybook on their own and ask to recall some characters and incidents of the story by asking simple questions related to the story.

Show and Tell: Child can choose any one object from their surrounding and **encourage them to speak** few lines on it. Prepare him/her to share and present that is special to your child– a toy, a book, a photo in the class once the school reopens. Child can use props or pictures for this activity.

Time for fun with music: Rhymes play an important role in the growth and development of children. It helps them to develop **auditory skills, modulate voice and speech development.**

So, to enhance these skills and have fun with music, make your child listen to rhymes and learn at least two rhymes from the big EVS textbook.

LET'S IMBIBE SOME MORAL VALUES AND SAVE THE ENVIRONMENT

1. Make your child a responsible citizen:

- Motivate him/ her to never throw the wrappers around.
 - Find a bin nearby and put the wrapper in it. No dustbin nearby: put the wrapper in your pocket and a put it in dustbin when you find one.
 - Encourage them to make a small bin for the car or carry an eco-friendly bag to dispose-off any wrappers.
- 'NEVER THROW THEM ON STREETS'.

2. 'RESOURCES ONCE WASTED CAN NOT BE USED BY ANYONE'.

- Motivate your child to turn off lights and other electrical appliances whenever they leave the room.
- Guide your child to take a small portion of serving (food) in the plate, so as he/she can finish the food.
- Guide your child not to waste water. Every drop is precious!
