Activity 1

Activity & Instructions: Think yourself to be a TV Presenter who is presenting a television feature on the monuments and architecture of any city of your choice. You could use the following tips while creating your video for the feature:

- 1) History behind the monument (Who built it? When? Why?)
 - 2) Distinct features of the monument (Building style, art, sculpture)
 - 3) Any special stories, legends, beliefs related to the monument.
 - 4) Current state of preservation of the monument
 - 5) The need to preserve and the measures to protect it for our future generations.
- The video should be between 1 min to 1min 30 secs. Any element of amusement would be appreciated.



Learning Outcome: Speaking and observation skills will be improved. Students will enhance their vocabulary and reading skills.

Competency Built: This activity will inculcate speaking skills, aesthetic appreciation and observation skills.

Activity 2



Be the nature protector -Make a bird feeder with waste materials.

Gather material: Collect all the necessary materials and supplies for your chosen craft project. This may include wooden or cardboard box, Coloured paper, Ice cream sticks, Colours, Cutter, Seeds, Rope and any other material required to complete your craft.

Follow instructions-Read through the instructions for your craft project carefully, paying attention to each step and detail. Follow the instructions closely to ensure a successful outcome.

Method – Take a cardboard box and either colour it or paste colourful paper on it. With the help of cutter cut an oval or rectangular shape for keeping the seeds. Make the roof with ice cream sticks by colouring it and pasting it on the cardboard. Use your creativity and imagination to personalise the project.

Presentation- Once your craft project is complete, take pride in showcasing your creation. Display your craft in a prominent place at home and take photos to shares with your class teacher.

Activity 3

- **Hydrate yourself-** Learn to prepare 2 recipes of delicious fruit mocktails that refresh you this summer.

Activity 4

Activity :-Use handmade paper OR cartridge sheet to design vocabulary amelioration bag filled with new words that you come across during your summer vacation. Write the word on a coloured strip of paper with its meaning and put it in the bag.

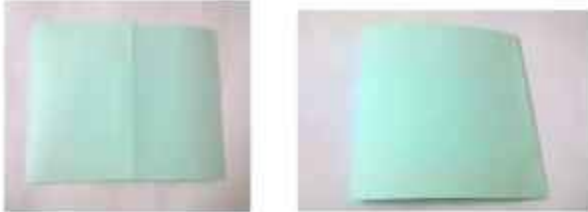
Follow the instructions given below to make it.

How to make a Vocabulary Amelioration Paper Bag

For this you will need:

1. Chart paper (or any other thick paper)
2. Glue
3. Scissors
4. Handle for the bag
5. Punching machine
6. Colours
7. An interesting scene from the book

Step 1: Take a piece of chart paper and make a crease at the centre.



Step 2: Paste the two sides together with glue. Allow it to dry for some time.



Step 3: Fold both sides of the paper. The thickness of the fold will determine the space inside the bag; this will become the width of the bag, so accordingly make the fold.



Step 4: Open the folds and along the creases made fold inwards on both the sides as shown.



Step 5: Fold the bottom of the bag for a length of around 2 inches. This will depend on the size of the bag you are making.



Step 6: Unfold the last fold made. Along the side crease, fold inwards to form a triangular shaped edge.



Step 7: Fold the flap inwards and flatten it as shown below. Paste the two flaps together using glue and press so that the base is firm.



Step 8: Using a punching machine, make two holes on both sides of the bag to attach the handle.



Step 9: Add some colour to it, use watercolours or poster colours to add some designs to one side of the bag. Draw any interesting scene from the story on the other side.



Step 10 Attach a handle to the bag using the holes made. You can attach simple plastic or thread handles to the bag as well.
