Student needs to practice writing one page of English & one page of Hindi in a separate notebook on an alternate basis during the holidays & the same has to be brought to school on reopening.

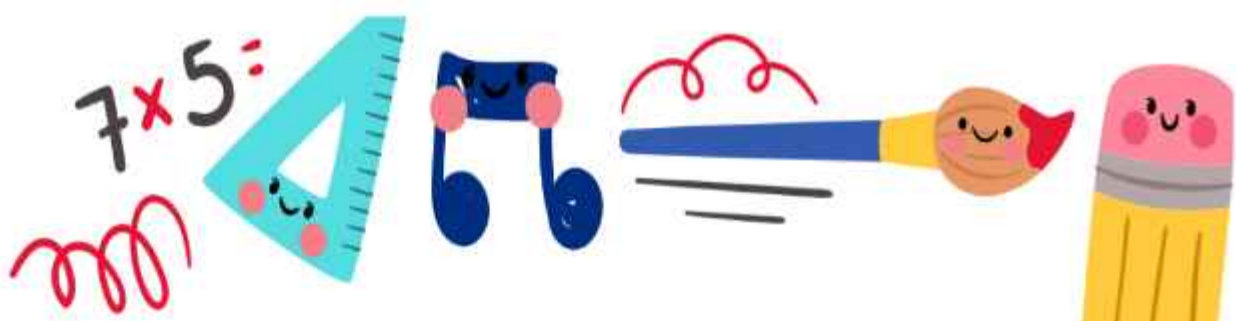

Shapes in nature – Get moving, explore nature and get creative. Take your child out for a nature walk and help him/her to find shapes in the nature. Gather items and paste them on the cut out of the shapes. Ex. Paste the square objects on a big square cut out, circle objects on a big circle cut out, triangle objects on a big triangle cut out, rectangle objects on a big rectangle cut out. (Take thick coloured sheets to make big cut out of the shapes).

Cloth folding activity (fine motor skills)– First arrange a towel, now spread out the towel on a low flat surface. Fold one side toward the centre. Repeat on the other side. Next fold both the top and bottom ends of the towel toward the middle, leaving a small space where the two ends meet. Align the two ends and fold one side over the other.

Feed the stray animals & birds – 'Sharing is caring' this old famous saying has been such an integral part of our lives. Thousands of stray dogs, cats, cows as well as birds like sparrows, pigeons are struggling to find food so go and feed some of them. The best food for stray animals is boiled rice/ vegetables / chapati. You can also keep a bowl of water for birds in your balcony.

Go on a leaf hunt – This activity is the same as going bird spotting except with leaves. Students can go and pick different leaves from trees. Spot the difference in colour, size & shapes of the leaves. Paste them in a scrap book.
